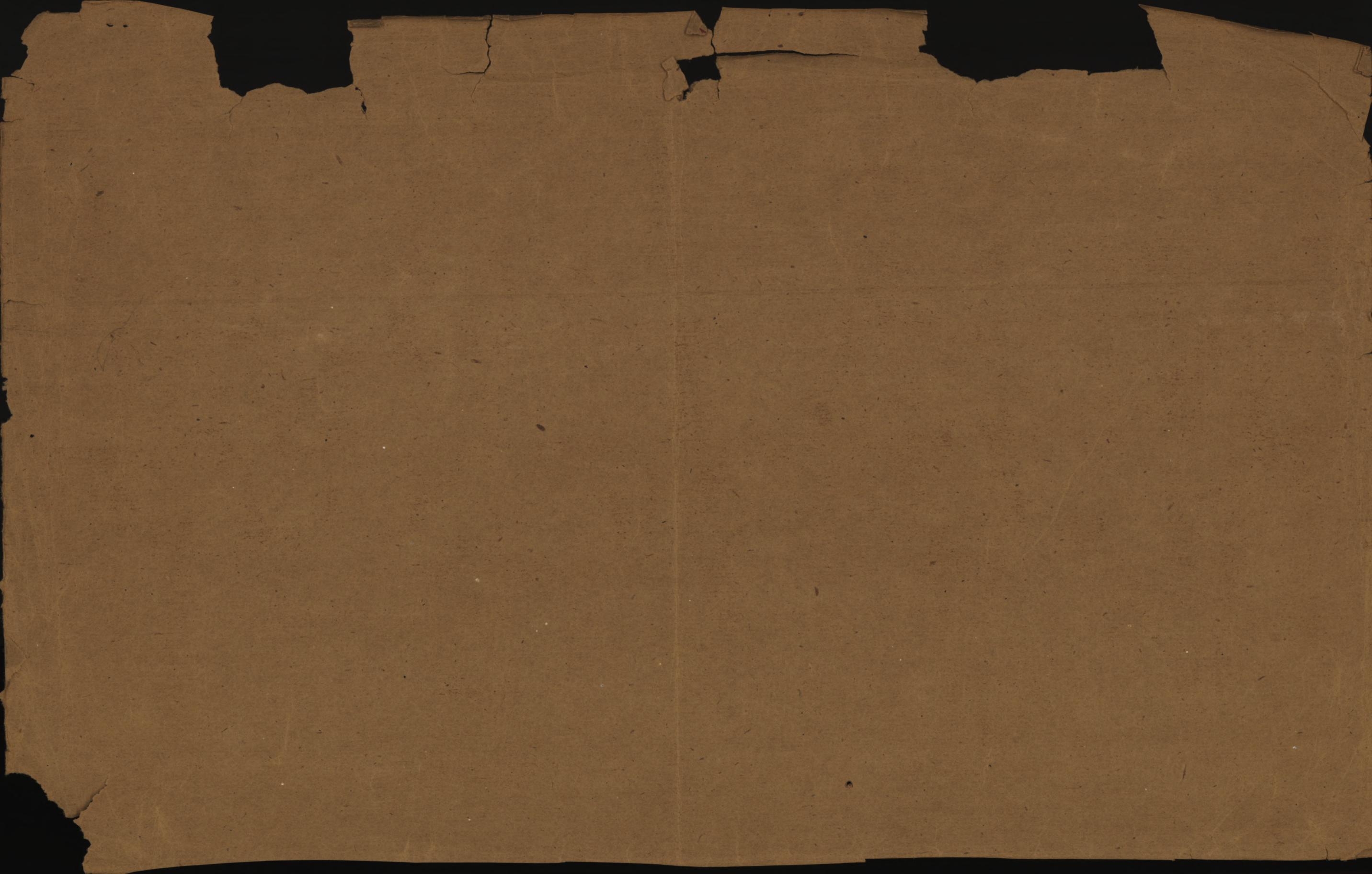

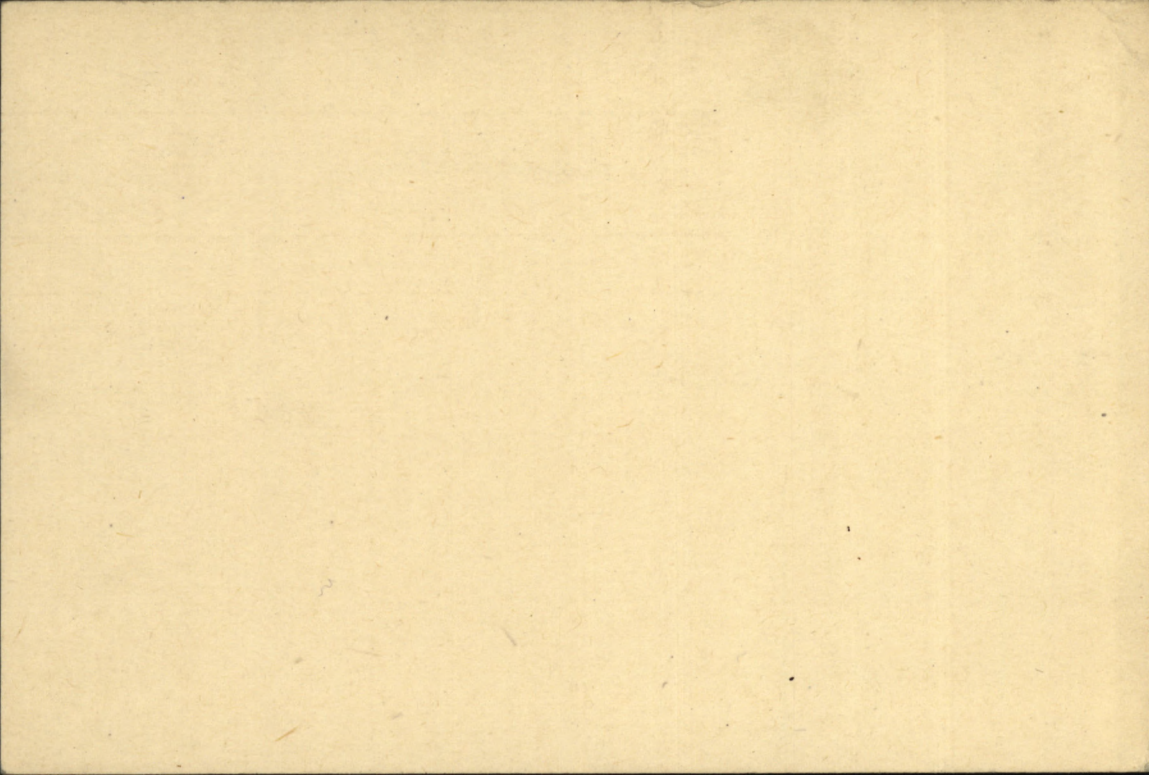

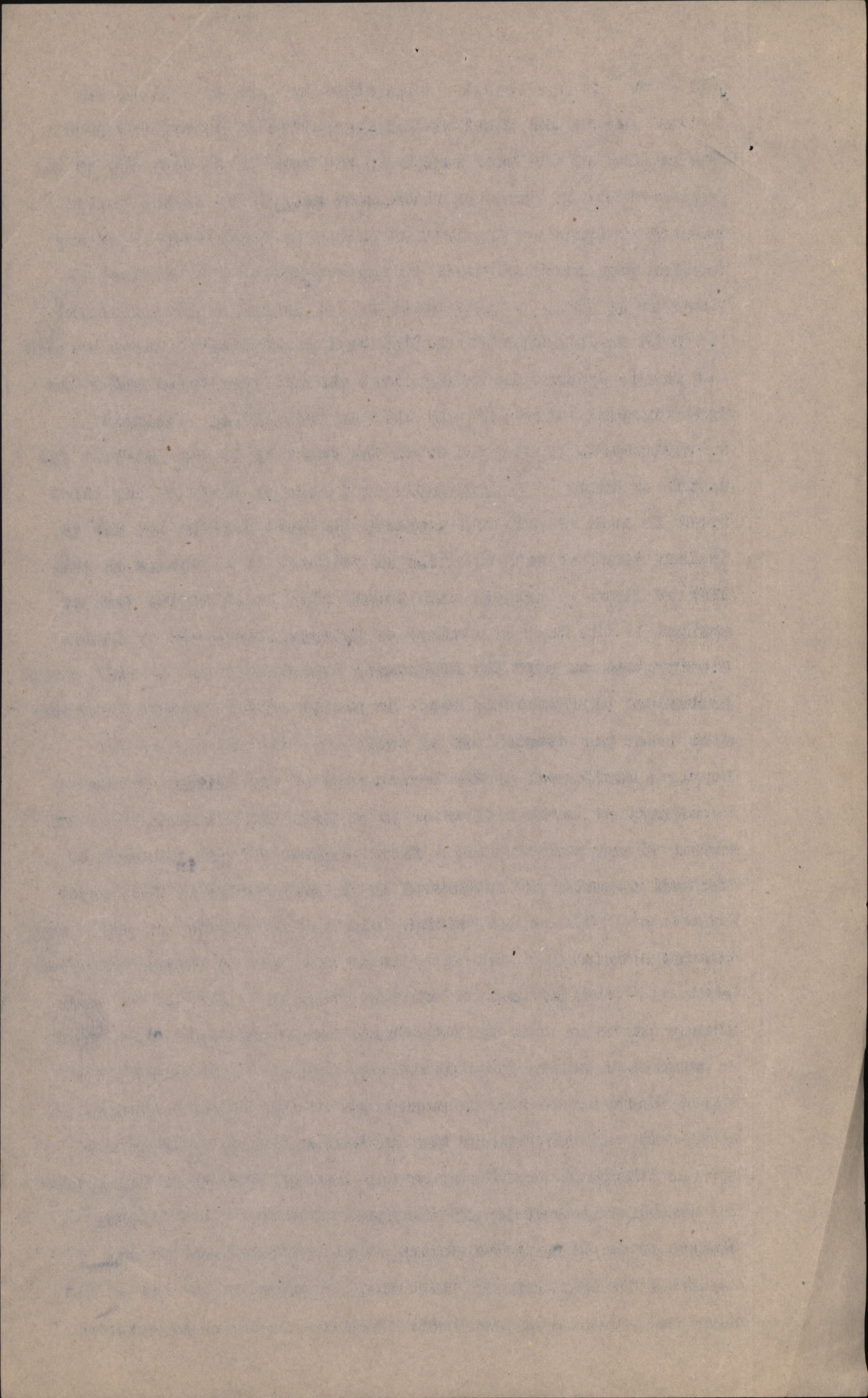
2. I BEQUEATH my gold watch and chain to my nephew Hugh Castell Pearson
