

Lieutenant Moon Ord, who had been given a Commission in the Durham Light Infantry, went to the Front in 1916. He was wounded at Martin puich, on October 10th, 1916, and died of pneumonia in hospital at Sunderland, on December 2nd, 1916.

DEATH OF LIEUT. MOON ORD.

The death occurred at the Hamerton House Hospital this morning of Lieutenant Charles Duncan Moon Ord, fourth son of Mr. and Mrs. H. Moon Ord, of 4, The Esplanade. The deceased officer, who was 31 years of age, was given a commission in the D.L.I. in March, 1915, and had served several months at the front. He was wounded in the arm on 10th October last, and in consequence returned to England. After being in hospital at Lanchester, he came home convalescent, but early this week he caught a chili and pneumonia developed, and he was taken to the Hamerton House Hospital, where, as stated, he died this morning. Lieut. Moon Ord, who was unmarried, was a brother of Mrs Vaux, wife of Lieut. Colonel E. Vaux. D.S.O., C.M.G.
