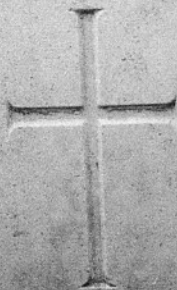
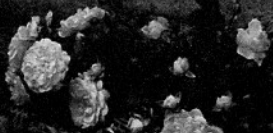

Turning into the village from the N.39 on the D.75, the Cemetery lies south on a road leading from the centre of the village.
